

ABERDEEN VILLAGE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
JANUARY 2, 2007

Monday January 2, 2007 at 7:30 p.m., the Aberdeen Village Council met in regular session. In attendance were Lawrence, Renchen, Phillips, Hutchison, Blankenbickler, Adm. Lindsay, Mayor Meadows, Angie Rushmeyer, asst. fiscal officer.

Roll call taken. Prayer by Renchen. Pledge by all.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with Lawrence stating that the Rt. 52 grant meeting was held at RULH middle school instead of the Aberdeen City Bldg.

Mayor asked for motion to pay bills, motion made by Lawrence, Hutchison 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Roll call taken with all voting yea. Motion carried to pay bills.

Committee Reports

Lawrence read letter from Village of Aberdeen stating that the Rt. 52 walk will be an asset and help insure children's safety as well as citizens. Council members signatures needed, signatures gotten. Letter will be sent in with grant. Inquired about the Ohio Enterprise Zone program which gives any new business a tax break, asked if Village is using it. If not in place we need to put in place.

Checked the cost of new signs for Village. Cost approx. \$4000, Lawrence will try to get lower costs. State Highway fund can be used for this. Mayor stated that light component for new bridge is needed.

Wireman, said that street signs in village are in need of repair, some missing. Mayor will get this taken care of.

Officer Newman gave report of Police Dept. A call log is now in place, and all calls will be recorded. All paper work is updated and straightened out. The department is running smooth. Also the department is looking into new uniforms (similar to State Highway Patrol) and wants to design a new Village patch. The police department has signed the village up for state bids. Enables the Village to bid on items from patrol cars to office equipment.

Mayor announced next council meeting will be Tuesday January 16 at 7:30 p.m.

Mayor presented the 2007 contract from Solicitor Cutrell in amount of \$6,000. First time for fee increase. Cutrell gives village one meeting per month, 10 hours quarterly total 40 hours a year, his hourly rate will remain at \$125.

Mayor asked for resolution to accept solicitor contract.

Blankenbickler made motion, Hutchison 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call taken with Lawrence, yea; Renchen yea; Phillips, no; Hutchison, yea; Blankenbickler, yea. Motion carried to accept resolution for solicitor contract.

Council Members

Lawrence, the Robert Rules need voted in.

Lawrence made motion, Renchen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call taken with all voting yea. Motion carried to accept Robert Rules.

Mayor asked for motion to accept the Ohio Basic Code Book. Hutchison made motion, Blankenbickler 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call taken. Motion carried to accept the Ohio Basic Code Book..  
Renchen- nothing

Phillips- questioned Babb hours, and the status of annexation. Mayor said Babb would return to 40 hours shortly.


