JUNE 3, 1996 MINUTES

THE ABERDEEN VILLAGE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION WITH MAYOR HIMES PRESIDING. THE MEETING OPENED AT 7:00 PM. ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS WERE PRESENT.

THE MINUTES WERE READ AND APPROVED. ROLAND PAYNE ASK ABOUT THE WATER FOUNTAIN (AT THE PARK) AND WHETHER IT HAD BEEN REPAIRED AND NOTED THAT THE PARK NEEDED CLEANED UP.

MAYOR HIMES GAVE HIS MONTHLY REPORT AND PRESENTED THE VILLAGE WITH A CHECK FOR \$10,291.00 AND THE STATE A CHECK FOR \$1,820.00.

BILL ASBURY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE LIST OF BILLS WITH THE FOLLOWING CORRECTIONS.

1. THE 55.51 TO ARAMARK WAS TO COME FROM THE STREET FUND.
2. BROWN CO CONSTR BILL FOR 2200.00 WAS TO BE ADDED AS PART OF THE VILLAGES IN-KIND COST FOR THE BOAT RAMP.
3. THE REAPPROPRIATION REQUEST WAS TO BE APPROVED. SECOND BY DAVID WIREMAN, ALL IN FAVOR.

MAYOR HIMES NOTED THAT DURING THE DAY HE WAS GOING TO HAVE THE FIRST THREE PARKING PLACES OUTSIDE THE BUILDING RESERVED FOR VISITORS.

JUNE CURTIS MADE A MOTION TO DISPOSE OF THE REQUEST FROM THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, SECOND BY ORVILLE FRAZIER. BILL ASBURY AND JOE ED HOWARD VOTED NO. MOTION CARRIED WITH 4 YES 2 NO.

IT WAS NOTED THAT THE RUGGLES ANNEX SHOULD BE TAKEN CARE OF WITHIN THE FOLLOWING WEEK.

MAYOR HIMES INFORMED EVERYONE THAT AS OF DATE THE RESPONSE TO THE SURVEY LETTERS WERE 63 YES, 42 NO AND 5 UNDECIDED.

THE MAYOR INFORMED COUNCIL THAT HE AND GARY SCOTT HAD MET WITH THE STATE BUILDING INSPECTOR AND THAT THEY HAD DEVISED A PLAN SO THAT A RAMP WOULD NOT BE NEEDED AT THE OLD SCHOOL. THIS WAS THE INSTALLATION OF AN INTERCOM SYSTEM IN THE GYM. ROLAND PAYNE MADE A MOTION THAT THE VILLAGE PROCEED ACCORDING TO THE STATE BUILDING INSPECTOR, SECOND BY JUNE CURTIS, ALL IN FAVOR.

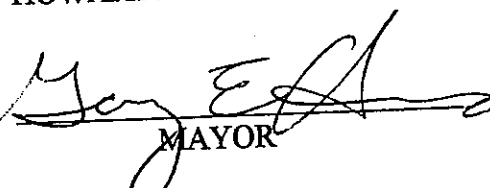
