

VILLAGE OF ABERDEEN
AUGUST 6, 2007
REGULAR MEETING

Monday August 6, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. the Aberdeen Village Council met in regular session.

Prayer given by Councilman Chamness. Pledge to flag by all.

Roll call taken with Councilman Chamness, Lawrence, Renchen, Phillips, Hutchison, in attendance, also present were, vice mayor Blankenbickler, Adm. Germann.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read with one correction, then approved.

Vice mayor asked for motion to pay bills. Discussion about bills regarding cruisers.

Motion to pay bills made by Phillips, Lawrence 2nd. Roll call taken.

Motion to pay bills carried.

Mayors monthly report \$3,679 to Village, \$555 to State of Ohio.

Department Heads:

Administrator Germann:

Germann reported the village is on a gasoline rotation schedule.

A new truck has been purchased for the village \$24,615..

Also purchased a scanner for \$79. this will be used for ordinances, etc.

Reported that Lawrence and himself attended a Workers Comp meeting, and as long as Adm. Or Lawrence attends a monthly meeting the village will receive a 2% decrease.

Looking for ways to decrease Workers Comp.

The sewer situation at Elm Streets is being addressed.

The old city building has been painted and the inside is getting organized. Will hold an auction in the near future.

Looking to start a 2008 Village project list, wants to get with council members and get their ideas.

Spoke with Solicitor Cutrell regarding setting up a non profit fund to be used so village can receive donations from organizations.

Has requested a refund from the IRS for the excise tax, approx. \$1500.

Police Department:

Cruiser picked up 2005 model, getting it equipped.

Walking Path Committee: Lawrence said that the state has picked Aberdeen for walking path, waiting on paperwork.
