

VILLAGE OF ABEREDREEN, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2016-07

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON VARIOUS STREETS IN THE VILLAGE
OF ABERDEEN

WHEREAS, the village administration has received complaints about dangerous parking situations in the Village of Aberdeen; and

WHEREAS, the village council of Aberdeen has determined that it is necessary to establish new parking regulations on various streets in the Village of Aberdeen in order to ensure the safety of village residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Aberdeen, Brown County, Ohio, a majority of its members there of concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village of Aberdeen hereby enacts Section 76.13 of the Village of Aberdeen Codified Ordinances, as set forth in the attached "Exhibit A"


SECTION 2. All other Ordinances regulating parking, with the exception of those listed in Section 76 of the Aberdeen Codified Ordinances, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken in open meetings of this council, and that deliberations of this council and its committees resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in accordance with all statutory requirements including the requirements in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code

SECTION 4. If any article, section or part of section of this Ordinance or Section shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance or Section nor the context in which such article, section or part of section so held invalid may appear, except to the extent that an entire article, section or part of section may be inseparably connected in meaning and effect with the article, section or part of section to which such holding shall directly apply.

EXHIBIT A

76.13

(A) No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon the following village streets, except that the driver may stop temporarily during the actual loading or unloading, and then for a period not to exceed 30 minutes.

(1) Huntington Parkway; Friendship Lane; Friendship Road; Bradford Lane; Circle Drive; Ridgeway Road; Braeburn Road; Christopher Road; Big Three Mile Road; Litton Circle; Barbour Drive; Vista Drive; Stivers Avenue; Campbell Drive; Stivers Road; River Road; Budig Drive; W. Budig Drive; Lykins Drive; Glenda Drive; Martin Drive; Denver Drive; Washington St.; Pennsylvania St.; Maryland St.; High St.; Lower Alley; Maple Alley; Short St.; Plum Alley; Pleasant Alley; Fish Alley; Mountain St; Lower Locust St.; Water St.

(B) The restrictions in Section 76.13(1) do not apply to the following:

- (1) Any street that is private property
- (2) Any street that has not been accepted into the street and road of the Village of Aberdeen
- (3) Gravel, paved or grassy areas adjacent to the street that are not used for vehicular traffic.

(C) Permits which allows for one day variances of the restrictions in this subsection may be issued by the following:

- (1) Mayor
- (2) Village Administrator
- (3) Simple motion of council

(D) The application for a permit does not guarantee one will be issued.

(E) Penalty see Section 70.99
